Travel costs, accommodation & food are covered by ERASMUS+

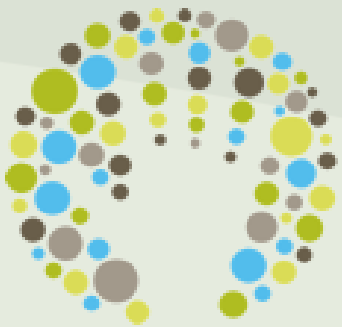
